

Call for applications for an extraordinary international orchestra project

- featuring PETER AND THE WOLF and other orchestra pieces for education concerts
- in collaboration with Kammerorchester Unter den Linden and Landesmusikakademie Berlin (holding an international conducting course for young conductors)
- with a final concert at the Berlin Philharmonie (Chamber Music Hall)
- conductors: Martin Braun and Andreas Peer Kähler

Berlin, 14 June 23 (arrival before 13.00 h) - 18 June 23 (final concert ending 17.00 h)

The project is not a course like our popular orchestra courses around New Year. Therefore, no course fee has to be paid, however, no special service is offered for room and board and no travel expenses are covered either. Instead, a fee of 400 € is paid for covering all expenses.

On 17 June, the orchestra will play for the participants of an international conducting course. The four best conductors of the course will - together with Martin Braun - also conduct the concert at the Philharmonie.

The **GERMAN-NORDIC YOUTH PHILHARMONIC** is an international youth orchestra whose work takes place in the form of orchestral courses in Berlin. The annual German-Nordic Orchestral Week goes back to the initiative of conductor Andreas Peer Kähler, who has been the orchestra's artistic director since its initial gathering during the turn of the year 1981/1982. The orchestra brings together young musicianfrom all over the world, predominately university students, but there are also aspiring professionals and students from schools who are contemplating a career as musicians. The orchestra's core is traditionally made up of both German and Scandinavian musicians, but the orchestra's line-up has become more international over the last years. Since 2021 and every year in june the GERMAN-NORDIC YOUTH PHILHARMONIC also organizes a chamber orchestra project with a final (family) concert at the Philharmonie – in collaboration with Kammerorchester Unter den Linden which is specialized in education work.
